


#### Mark and drill door.


Using template, mark

- · Centre of door edge
- 6mm holes x 2
- 20mm hole through door.




- Drill 25mm hole square to door edge, 100mm deep
- Drill 20mm hole through door face from both sides
- Drill 2x 6mm holes through door face from both sides














#### Fit spindle through latch.

Offest hole at the bottom.
Slide spindle in from outside
face of door until spindle comes to a
solid stop inside latch.
Note: O-ring groove on inside.








Note: From inside face.

# 6 Check O-ring is seating correctly in spindle.


Check to make sure spindle cannot slide out. O-ring should hold spindle in firmly.






### IMPORTANT STEP.

Fit through bolt fixing screw.




## 8 Fit both handles onto spindle.

Fit 4x wood screws each side.



#### 9 Fit cover plates over handles.


Tighten up grub screws onto the spindle using allen key provided.







Fit bathroom snib to inside handle.





#### Check action while door is open.

- Push snib button, check outside is locked.
- Pull on inside handle. It should pop off button.
- If ok, check operation with door closed.
